I will show my love for the earth by ...

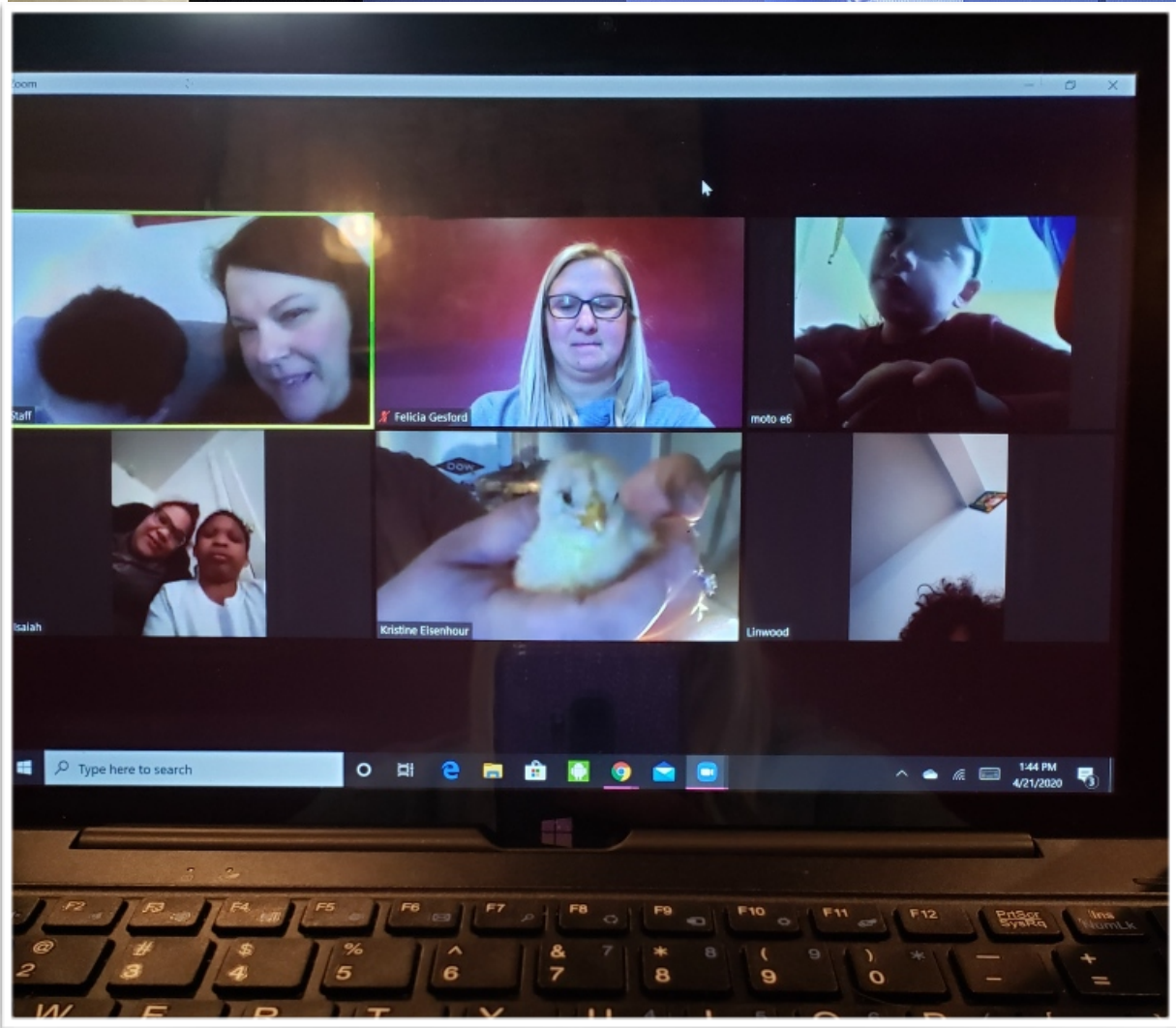
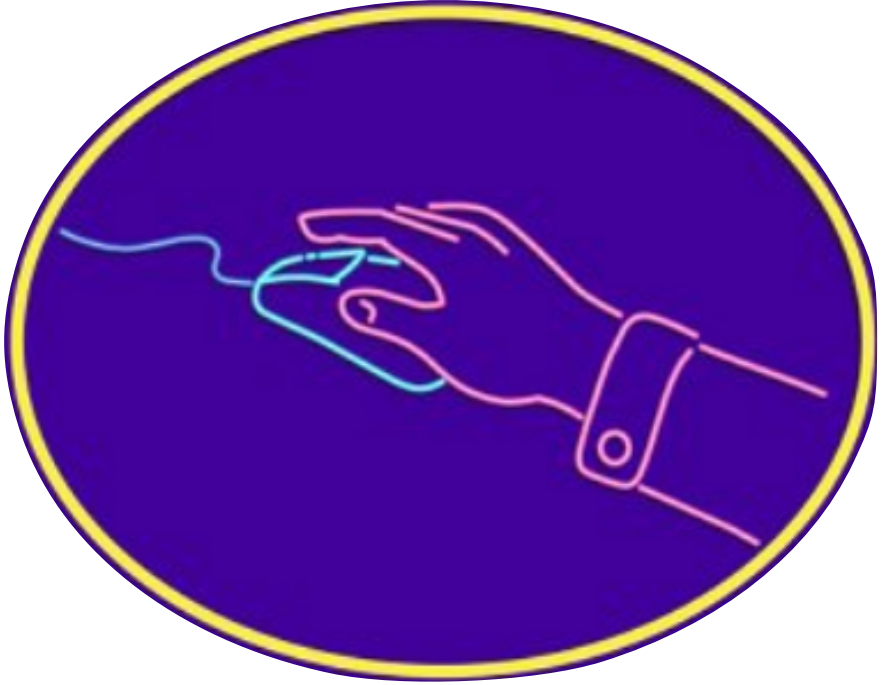
...paying attention to my surroundings of who is littering and who is throwing recyclables in the trash. I will correct them and pick up after them. [TayShawn]

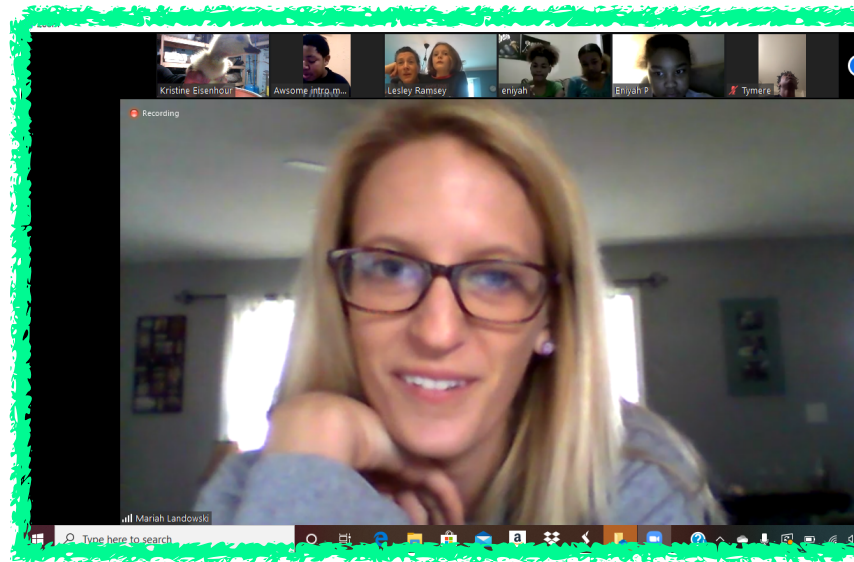
A note from Mrs. L...
